

HQC QUILT REGISTRATION GUIDELINES for 2025

1. As a member of HCQ, you are encouraged to enter at least one quilt in our show.
2. Please use one registration form for each separate item. Pre-registration is required. Registration forms must be **received by Janet Hague**, 755 Forty Foot Rd., 19440, **no later than Monday, March 3, 2025**.
3. For insurance purposes, a value is required to be stated on each form.
4. Each item MUST HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE EXHIBITOR. No item will be accepted if it was exhibited in a previous HCQ Show unless it was shown unfinished in an educational display. Antique quilts will not be exhibited.
5. All items to be exhibited will be received at the 4-H Center in Creamery on **Tuesday, April 1, 2025 between 10AM and 12 NOON**.

Your quilts may be picked up on **Saturday, April 5, 2025 from the gym ONLY AFTER ALL QUILTS from every display area are brought to the gym and sorted by the room in which the quilt was hung. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS to this procedure.**

6. All quilts must be prepared for hanging. A 4" sleeve must be attached to the top of the back of each quilt with the exception of a small wall-hanging.
7. If a quilt is longer than 85", in order to not have to pin it up from the bottom, put the 4" sleeve at 85". This will help preserve your quilt so we don't have to pin it to keep it off the floor.
8. Each item must have a cloth label sewn securely to the back of the work with your name and phone number on it. A photo of each individual quilt must be attached to each registration form.
9. **FOLD QUILTS RIGHT SIDE OUT FOR REGISTRATION.**

10. The person entering the quilt piece is responsible for delivery and pick-up. YOU are responsible for YOUR work. Your work will not be returned to someone else unless we have written authorization from you to do so. If you know ahead of time that someone else will deliver and/or pick up your work, please note that information on the registration form.
11. Every reasonable effort will be made to protect your work. The HCQ and Quilt Show Committee will not be responsible for any loss or damage.
12. Only Quilts, which have been pre-registered, will be accepted for the show. Absolutely no walk-in registrations will be handled by the Committee. If for any reason your quilt cannot be submitted on Tuesday, April 1, please contact Judy Trumbore or Marianne Saboe prior to the March deadline (see #2 above).
13. Please present your HCQ Receipt to pick-up your quilt.
